



## Santa Claus for Romanian Children

is a charitable action organised, every year, by Romanian Open Society Abroad, in Brussels and in other capitals of Europe.

Romanian people living abroad collect funds and objects in order to fill in shoe boxes, wrap them nicely and send them to children with special needs in Romania, for Christmas. The group age targeted is 2-12 years old, boys and girls. But exceptions can be made.



### Our recommendations for the objects:

- Toys adapted to the group ages (there may be used toys, but in good condition)
- Clothes: gloves, socks, jacket, jumper, hat, scarf, T-shirt etc. (clothes may be used, but in good condition, with no marks)
- Sweets of all sorts
- Toothpaste and brush
- Stationary which can be used at school (pens, pencils, notebook etc.)
- Forbidden: liquids, glass objects or quickly perishable food products

Each present has approx. 1Kg. Presents arrive in Romania on 15 December the latest. The distribution takes place in various locations in the country between 16-25 December. The lists with local volunteer groups and the places where they distribute presents are public, on our website:
